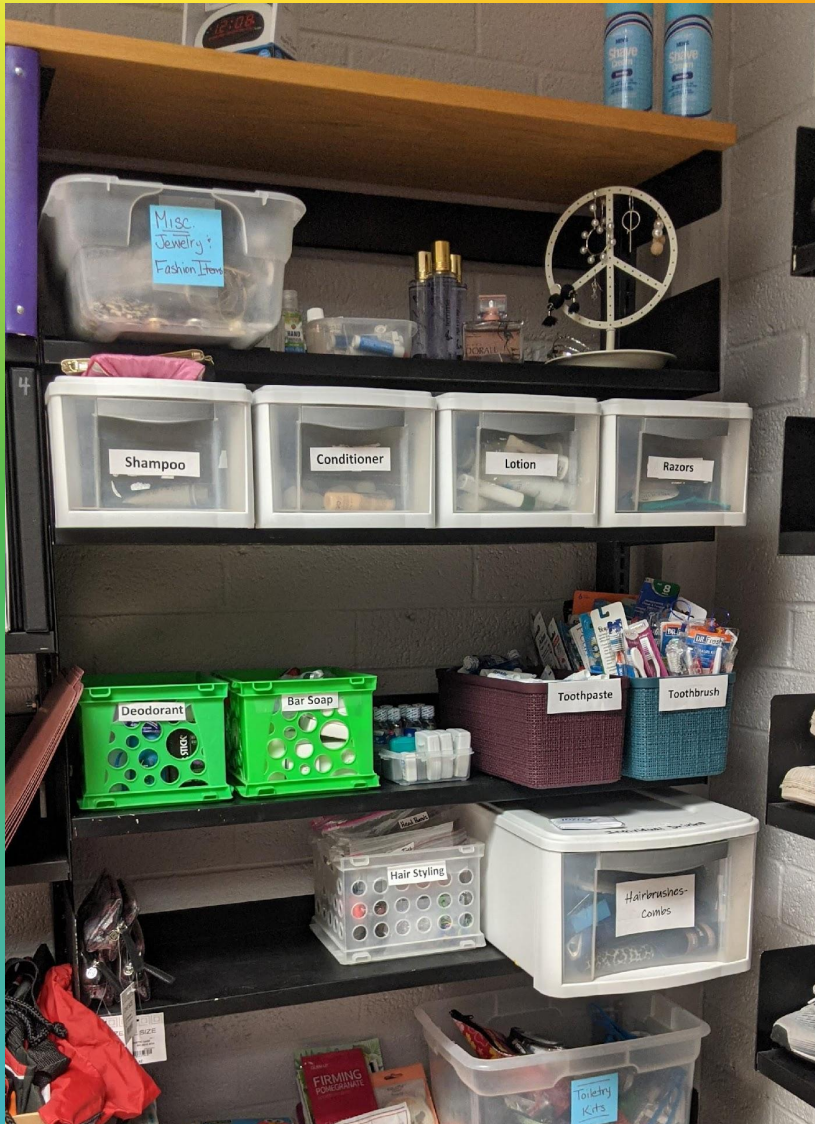
# classroom supplies

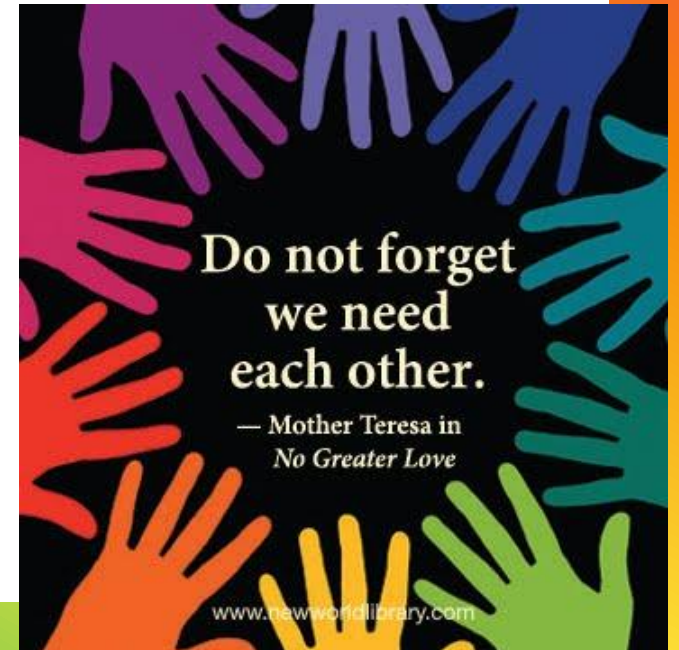
# How does this all work?
