- 4) Leadership, as demonstrated by work and/or extracurricular activities;
- 5) Academic performance; minimum GPA of 3.0.

- A. Submit Mingus Connection Scholarship Application,
- **B.** An essay not to exceed one page describing, in your own words, personal character and leadership abilities, achievements, and your ultimate educational/career goals;
- C. Letters of recommendation from:
 - 1) High School counselor/advisor; and
 - 2) High school teacher
 - 3) Employer or Mentor, if relevant
- D. Copy of current high school official transcript;
- E. FAFSA results or previous year parent and student federal tax returns; include explanation of any circumstances that will affect your family's ability to help you finance your future education (such as excessive expenses, care of a parent, personal crisis, etc.).

Deadline: Completed application due by March 27th each year.
