

The Rotary Club of the Verde Valley is once again offering Academic Scholarship Awards to area high school seniors. Preference will be given to applicants from accredited public/charter/private schools in the Cottonwood, Camp Verde and Cornville areas.

The awards support selected applicants who will attend an accredited Community College or four-year University in pursuit of a Bachelor's degree beginning in the Fall of 2025. The Verde Valley Rotary Club also awards Vocational Scholarships; the applicant cannot apply for both. You are eligible to apply for the Academic Scholarship if you plan to begin at a Community College and continue to a University.

Selection Criteria:Graduating high school senior during the 2024-25 school year.<br/>Scholastic standing in the top 25% of the graduation class.<br/>Financial need.<br/>School involvement and honors.<br/>Community involvement.
