### Graduation Information and Expectations

**Senior Honors Night** - We are extremely proud of the academic accomplishments of our seniors. We will hold a special ceremony on Monday, May 20th in the Mingus Union High School auditorium at 6:00 p.m. There will be a reception with light refreshments prior to the event at 5:30pm. If your student is being recognized for an award or scholarship, they will receive an invitation; however, all seniors and their families are welcome to attend. The attire for this evening is professional business attire.

**Academic and Account Standing** – It is important that each student complete all necessary coursework required for graduation as determined by the Arizona Department of Education and Mingus Union High School. If you have any questions about graduation requirements or your student's status, please contact the Counseling Office at 928-634-7531 ext. 1402. All graduates must pay any outstanding student account fees and turn in all senior paperwork by May 10th. All Chromebooks, textbooks, library books, and athletic uniforms must be returned prior to graduation, or a fee will be assessed, and all fees on accounts must be paid. Students will not be permitted to walk in the graduation ceremony if they have outstanding fees.

**Cap and Gown** - Order your cap, gown, and tassel by going to our website [www.mingusunion.com](http://www.mingusunion.com) click on the parent or student tab, then senior graduation store. Students may pick up their caps and gowns in the bookstore once the order and payment are complete. If you have a financial hardship and are in need of a cap and gown, please contact Sarah Garrett in the Hope Center.

**Graduate Dress Code** - Our graduation ceremony is an important community tradition and a final learning experience for our proud students; our dress code reflects this belief.

- Men: dress shirt, pants/slacks, clean shoes (dress shoes are preferred and ties are optional)
- Ladies: dress, skirt, or dress pants/slacks – be careful with heel height, it is a long walk, and we do not want you to take a fall on your special night!
- No shorts, t-shirts, jeans, or flip-flops – no extremely informal attire
- No decoration on the graduation gown. No leis, boas, etc. – only school approved medals/cords are allowed.
- Graduation caps may be decorated, but the decoration must lay flat. No 3D or decorations hanging off the side. *Any decoration which would draw undue or negative attention is not permitted.*
- **Red gown, cap, tassel:** the cap is to be worn flat on the head with the point at the center of the forehead and tassel on the right side. Red gown must be fully zipped for the ceremony.

**Appropriate Behavior** - If your child participates in a destructive or dangerous senior prank and/or demonstrates behavior that is not school appropriate, he or she will forfeit the privilege of participating in senior activities and/or walking at Graduation. If damage is caused to the school, no matter how little, law enforcement will be involved. Any behavior that draws attention away from the speakers, performers, or individual graduates being honored, or detracts from the dignity of the ceremony itself will result in removal from the ceremony.

We ask our proud parents to please respect all the graduates by remaining seated during the ceremony. Walking around on the field, engaging in conversations, or entering the student seating area for photographs is unfairly disruptive. Please do not enter the graduates' seating area.

Blown up beach balls, poppers, silly string, bull horns, etc. are not appropriate. Graduation parties are more appropriate for celebrations of this nature. Please discuss this issue with your graduate. We want to do everything possible to make this a cherished memory for all our students. A good rule of thumb, if the action takes away from the ceremony and focuses on an individual or group of individuals, then it is inappropriate and unacceptable. Thank you, in advance, for your understanding and cooperation.

**Location** - Graduation will be held on the Mingus Union High School football field, weather permitting.

**Diplomas** - Diplomas are legal documents and as such, will be printed in the student's legal name as it appears on their birth certificate. Diplomas will not be inside the red cover at graduation. Graduates will pick up their diplomas on the field following the graduation ceremony.

**Mandatory Graduation Practice** – Graduation rehearsal is mandatory for all seniors on Friday, May 24th at 7:00am. Students who do not attend graduation rehearsal will not participate in the graduation ceremony. If you have any questions, please contact the front office (Bridget Hillman) at 649-4386.

**Graduation Seating** - Each graduate will receive four field tickets once all school fees have been paid. **Tickets will be given to the graduates.** The office will not provide tickets to adults. Students need to pick up the tickets at the Bookstore **beginning May 6<sup>th</sup> through May 17<sup>th</sup>.** Mingus Union High School will not manage ticket issues related to family dynamics. Our hope is that four field tickets will allow for inclusion of all family structures.

The north football gates will open at **5:00 pm, Friday, May 24th**, for admission to the graduation ceremony. Seating in the bleacher area and the reserved on-field area (**with ticket**) is on a first come, first served basis, with no saving of seats. Admission to the accommodated seating area will require that the person present their ADA card/identification and they may be accompanied by one guest. Individuals who require special assistance can be dropped off at the gate and a cart will take them to the seating area.

**Parking** – There is limited parking at the high school– dropping off graduates early and carpooling is encouraged. Accommodated parking is available in the east parking lot by the cafeteria and monitored to assist those who need these spaces. Additional parking is available in the dirt parking lot, across Camino Real from the west lot, Fry's parking lot, and in the Faith Lutheran Church parking lot. Transportation (bus shuttles) to the school will be provided from these latter two parking areas both to the ceremony and back to the parking areas at the end of the ceremony.

**Live Stream Information** – Our graduation ceremony will be live-streamed on Verde Valley TV for family and friends to watch from home. Please visit [www.VerdeValleyTV.com](http://www.VerdeValleyTV.com) to be directed to a link for access.

**In Case of Rain** - In the event of inclement weather, we may have to move the ceremony inside; we will let you know by 5:00pm the day of graduation. We will contact families via our School Messenger\* phone service and have a public service announcement on KYBC AM 1600, KVRD FM 105.7, KKLD FM 95.9, KVNA FM 100.1 and KQST FM 102.9.

**Operation Graduation 2024!!** – Operation Graduation is a community event sponsored by the Mingus Connection working to provide our Marauders with a safe and exciting graduation party for the Class of 2024! Op Grad will take place at the Cottonwood Rec Center with doors opening at 9:00pm on graduation night. Graduates and guests must arrive by 10:30pm and students are not permitted to re-enter if they leave the building. So many prizes are available for our grads and all prizes will be raffled at the end of the event!
