Yavapai CattleWomen and Yavapai Cattle Growers are offering scholarship aid to deserving graduating seniors or continuing college student who will be carrying 12 or more credit hours per semester. Both group work together for the promotion of the beef industry. This year our scholarships will be in the amount of \$1500.00 each. Scholarships are based on points given for the following:

Student application must qualify for **ONE** or more of the following items:

- 1. Student applicants must be a resident of Yavapai County.
- 2. Student applicant is the son, daughter or relative of a current member of the Yavapai CattleWomen or Yavapai Cattle Growers.
- 3. Applicant's major is in the agricultural field.
- 4. Students may receive this scholarship only two times.
- 5. Applicant's parent or guardians or student's livelihood is derived in part from the cattle or agricultural industry.
- Other applicants will be considered.

Submit a current official copy of all high school and/or college transcripts, from the fall semester. Include your rank and number of students in your graduation class. This form must be completed and mailed together with your application.

Student application forms are to be completed by applicant either typed or neatly printed in ink. If you get you application from the Yavapaicowbelles.org website, it must be printed off and included with the other forms listed and postmarked by April 1, 2024.

Student applicants shall submit a dated letter of intent, preferably typed with all agricultural activities, classes, work in the field of your family or others, FFA and 4-H experience, future plans and goals that include work in the agricultural field. Let us know how many of your family, if anyone other siblings will be in college and of the financial needs of your family. If you plan to work this summer, during school, we would like to know of your work experience and how many hours per week. If part of your or your family's income is related to the agricultural industry, please explain. This letter is one of the very best ways the committee gets to know you. Please write a detailed letter.

Applicants must submit two (2) current dated letters of recommendation from teachers or persons other than relatives.

The applicant is to supply a current photo, suitable for publication. Photo cannot be returned.

Applications must be postmarked by March 15, 2024.

The scholarship shall be for any college, university, or vocational school. It shall be good only for the year issued. The scholarship will be divided between the 2 school semesters and sent out to the student upon receipt of proof of enrollment. This must be mailed to the treasurer; address will be provided in the acceptance letter. Exceptions shall be made for vocational schools.
