- Your processed FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov) that shows your Expected Family Contribution (EFC).
- A Personal Statement of at least 350 words that may include (but is not limited to) your interests, high school activities/clubs/leadership positions, community activities, educational goals, career goals, financial need, work experience, special considerations.
- Official transcript.

Deadline: Bring your scholarship folder to the Counseling office no later than March 27 (or the close of the previous school day).

 - Official transcript.
 - Any additional requirements stated in the scholarship abstract(s).

It is your responsibility to collect the required materials for each scholarship. Make sure that the Counseling Office has all of these materials no later than March 27 (or the close of the previous school day).
